Requirements for a Standard High School Diploma

DEFINITION: According to Florida Statute 1003.4282, "Beginning with students entering grade 9 in the 2013-2014 school year, receipt of a standard high school diploma requires successful completion of 24 credits, an International Baccalaureate curriculum, or an Advanced International Certificate of Education curriculum."

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE OR
ADVANCED INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION CURRICULUM OPTION:**

1. The student must commit to and complete the entire International Diploma curriculum with fidelity, including, but not limited to: internal assessments, external assessments, coursework, and compulsory program requirements and course offerings.
2. Should a student exit an International Diploma curriculum, the student would then be responsible for completing the courses necessary to satisfy the 24 credit high school diploma option.
